



# 1Password (Linux) cheat sheet

## X11

To use these default keyboard shortcuts or create your own, open and unlock 1Password, then click your account or collection at the top of the sidebar and choose Settings > General.

Ctrl + Shift + Space	Show Quick Access
Ctrl + Shift + L	Lock 1Password
Ctrl + \	Fill in Browser

## 1Password app

Ctrl + Shift + /	View keyboard shortcuts
Alt	Show or hide the app menu in the titlebar
Ctrl + ,	Open settings
Ctrl + Shift + Space	Open Quick Access
Ctrl + N	Create a new item
Ctrl + F	Search for items
Ctrl + Alt + F	Find items
Ctrl + 1	View All Accounts
Ctrl + 2	... to 9Switch accounts or collections
Ctrl + Shift + L	Lock 1Password
Alt + Left arrow	Back
Alt + Right arrow	Forward
Down arrow	Focus next row
Up arrow	Focus previous row
Right arrow	Focus right section
Left arrow	Focus left section
Enter or Space	Activate focused element
Ctrl + Shift + C	Copy password
Ctrl + Alt + C	Copy one-time password
Ctrl + Shift + F	Open the selected Login item in your default browser and fill your username and password
Ctrl + Alt	Reveal all passwords in the item details

To use this shortcut, click your account or collection at the top of the sidebar and choose Settings > Security. Then turn on “Hold Ctrl+Alt to toggle revealed fields”.

Ctrl + O	Open the selected item in a new window
Ctrl + E	Edit the selected item
Esc	Cancel an edit
Esc	Clear the search field
Ctrl + S	Save changes to an item
Del	Move the selected item(s) to the Archive
Ctrl + Del	Delete the selected item(s)
Ctrl + +	Zoom in
Ctrl + -	Zoom out
Ctrl + 0	Actual size

## Quick access

Ctrl + Shift + Space	Open or close Quick Access
Right arrow	View all available actions
Ctrl + C	Copy username
Ctrl + Shift + C	Copy password
Ctrl + O	Open item details in new window
Alt + Enter	Open & fill an item
Ctrl + Shift + O	Open an item in the app
Ctrl + +	Zoom in
Ctrl + -	Zoom out
Ctrl + 0	Actual size

## In web browser

To open the 1Password pop-up in Chrome, Edge, or Brave, press Shift + Ctrl + X, or in Firefox, press Control + Period (.), then you can use the following shortcuts:

Ctrl + I	Create new item
Ctrl + E	Edit the selected item
Enter	Copy the selected item detail
Enter	Perform the default action for the selected item
Ctrl + Enter	Open the website for the selected Login item in a new tab and fill your username and password
Ctrl + C	Copy the username of the selected item

Shift + Ctrl + C	Copy the password of the selected item
Shift + Ctrl + Super	Copy the one-time password of the selected item
Ctrl + Alt	Reveal all passwords in the item details
Ctrl + O	Open the selected item in a separate window
Ctrl + F	Search 1Password
Ctrl + Down arrow	Open the category menu
Ctrl + D	Show vaults
Ctrl + G	Show the password generator
Ctrl + C	Copy and save a password from the password generator
Esc	Dismiss the 1Password pop-up
Esc	Clear the search field
Space	Expand item overview banners
Ctrl + Shift + L	Lock 1Password
