Global

These shortcuts are available from any JIRA or JIRA Agile screen.

G then D	Go to Dashboard
G then P	Browse to a Project
G then A or G then H	Go to Agile
G then I	Go to Issue Navigator
G then G	Administration Search Dialog Box (Only available if you have the 'JIRA administrators' global permission)
/	Quick Search
C	Create an Issue
?	Open shortcut help
For Windows, Mod key is Alt + Shift in Firefox, Alt in Internet Explorer, and Ctrl for Safari.

Mod + D	Dashboards drop-down menu
Mod + P	Projects drop-down menu
Mod + I	Issues drop-down menu
Mod + G	Agile drop-down menu
Mod + S	Form Submit
Mod + `	Cancel Form

Agile

These shortcuts can only be used in Agile screens.

J	Next Issue
K	Previous Issue
N	Next Column
P	Previous Column
-	Expand/Collapse All Swimlanes
T	Hide/Show Detail View
O	View Issue
Enter	Add a New Line
Enter	Submit changes
Esc	Cancel changes
I	Assign to Me
S + T	Send to Top
S + B	Send to Bottom

E	Edit Issue
Z	Projector Mode (toggle between three modes)

Issue actions and navigator

These shortcuts are only available in the View Issue and Issue Navigator screens of JIRA.

O or Enter	View selected Issue
J	Next Issue
K	Previous Issue
U	Back to the Navigator
[Hide/Show Left Section
N	Next Activity
P	Previous Activity
F	Focus search field
Esc	Escape field. Escapes the cursor out of the current text field so that you can use more keyboard shortcuts

If the auto-complete dropdown list is visible on the Advanced Search text field, you need to press the Esc key twice to escape the cursor out of this text field.

E	Edit Issue
A	Assign Issue
M	Comment on Issue
M	(in Issue Navigator) Open Add Comment dialog
L	Edit Issue Labels
S	Share Issue
