| F                           | Opens the image in full screen mode  |

| Ctrl + C                    | Copies the currently displayed image to the Clipboard  |
| Ctrl + S                    | Opens the Save Image As dialog<br>box, in which you can save your<br>image with a different name or<br>file format     |
| Ctrl + P                    | Opens the current image in the ACDSee Free Print utility   |
| Ctrl + Alt + Left<br>arrow  | Rotates the current image 90° counterclockwise   |
| Ctrl + Alt + Right<br>arrow | Rotates the current image 90°<br>clockwise   |
| =                           | Increases the magnification of the current image (zooms in)  |
| Alt + Down arrow            | Zooms the image to fit the height<br>within the ACDSee Free window.<br>Does not enlarge, only reduces                  |
| Alt + Right arrow           | Zooms the image to fit the width<br>within the ACDSee Free window.<br>Does not enlarge, only reduces                   |
| Alt + F4                    | Closes ACDSee Free   |
| Alt + O                     | Opens the ACDSee<br>Free Options dialog box  |
| Shift + Ctrl + Alt +<br>W   | Sets the selected image as a centered desktop wallpaper  |
| Ctrl + Shift + W            | Sets the selected image as a tiled desktop wallpaper   |
| Ctrl + Alt + W              | Sets the selected image as a stretched desktop wallpaper   |
| Alt + W                     | Restores your desktop wallpaper<br>to the setting you were using<br>before you applied an ACDSee<br>Free wallpaper     |
| Backspace                   | Displays the previous item in the view sequence  |
| Ctrl + Left arrow           | Displays the previous image  |
| Ctrl + Right arrow          | Displays the next image  |

| Page Up           | Displays the previous item   |
| Space             | Displays the next image  |
| Shift + Backspace | Displays the previous image  |

| Shift + Space     | Opens the Save Image As dialog<br>box, in which you can save your<br>image with a different name or<br>file format |
