In Scroll Mode, hold down Ctrl key to switch to Rectangle Select Mode temporarily
In Select Mode, click and drag with Left Mouse Button to make a selection. Hold down Shift key to make multiple selections
Move selection one pixel at a time
Resize selection one pixel at a time
(on a selection) Move selection
Crop the image
Cancel the selection
Pan / scroll the image
Zoom in / out the image
Zoom in/out or scroll up/down the image based on the software Settings
Zoom in / out the image
Zoom the image to 100%, 200%, 300%,900%
Display the image in actual size (100%)
Fit the image to the window
Fit the selection to the window
Zoom in on the image
Zoom out on the image
Save the image
Save all changed images
Save the selected part of the image
Resize the image
Print the whole or part (if selected) of the image
Copy the whole or part (if selected) of the image to the

Ctrl + V	Paste from the Windows clipboard
Ctrl + X	Cut the selected part of the image
D	Draw texts, arrowed lines, highlights and other annotation objects on the image
E	Edit the image with a specified external editor
G	Apply edge effects to the image
т	Add a caption to the image
В	Obscure (blur) the selected area of the image
0	Apply a spotlight effect to the selected area of the image
Alt + W	Send the image to Microsoft Word
Alt + E	Send the image to Microsoft Excel
Alt + P	Send the image to Microsoft PowerPoint

The editor supports tabs that allow you to capture and edit multiple screenshots simultaneously. On the tab bar, click on button to make a screenshot in a new tab. Click on button to close a tab. Shortcuts to switch between tabs:

Alt + Left arrow / Right arrow	Previous / next tab
Alt + Home or Alt + End	First / last tab
Alt + Wheel up and wheel down	Previous / next tab
Alt + [1 - 9]	Open a recent file
Alt + A	Open all recent files
Esc	Close the editor
