

Firefox (macOS) cheat sheet

Navigation

Cmd + Left arrow	Back
Option + Home	Home
F5	Reload
Cmd + Shift + R	Reload (override cache)

Current Page

Tab	Focus Next Link or Input Field
Space	Go Down a Screen
Fn + Up arrow or Shift + Space	Go Up a Screen
End	Go to Bottom of Page
Option + Enter	Save Focused Link (-when browser.altClickSave is set to true (as in the Configuration Editor), which is not the default.)

Editing

Cmd + C	Copy
Cmd + X	Cut

Windows & Tabs

Cmd + Shift + P	New Private Window
-----------------	--------------------

Bookmarks

Cmd + B	Bookmarks sidebar
Cmd + Shift + B	Library window (Bookmarks)

Tools

Cmd + Alt + C	Inspector
Shift + F7	Style Editor

Miscellaneous

Cmd + Shift + F	Toggle Full Screen
F6 or Cmd + L	Focus Address Bar

Selection of Multiple Tabs

These shortcuts require the tab bar to be "in focus."
Currently, the only way to do this is to focus an

adjacent object and "tab into" the tab bar, for instance, by hitting command + L to focus the address bar, and then Shift + Tab repeatedly until the current tab gets a dotted rectangle.
