<	Decrease rating
>	Increase rating
R	Open in camera raw
O	Open
Alt + R	Open all in camera raw
Alt + O	Open all

## Stacks menu

Ctrl + G	Group as stacks
Ctrl + Shift + G	Ungroup from stack
Ctrl + Left arrow /	Open or close stack

Right arrow	
Ctrl + Alt + Right arrow	Expand all stacks
Ctrl + Alt + Left arrow	Collapse all stacks

## File menu

Ctrl + N	New window
Ctrl + Shift + N	New folder
Ctrl + O	Open
Ctrl + R	Open in camera raw
Ctrl + W	Close window
Ctrl + Del	Delete
Ctrl + Alt + O	Return to Adobe Photoshop
Ctrl + I	File info

Tab	Show/hide panels
Ctrl + '	Switch between 0- and 1-star rating
Ctrl + +	Increase thumbnail size
Ctrl + -	Decrease thumbnail size
Ctrl + Shift + +	Step thumbnail size up
Ctrl + Shift + -	Step thumbnail size down
Up arrow	Move up a folder (in Folders panel or a row)
Down arrow	Move down a folder (in Folders panel or a row)
Ctrl + Up arrow	Move up a level (in Folders panel)
Left arrow	Move left one item
Right arrow	Move right one item
Home	Move to the first item
End	Move to the last item
Ctrl + Left click	Add to selection (discontiguous)
F5	Refresh Contents panels
Shift + Arrow keys	Add an item to the selection

F1	Display Help
Tab	Rename next (with filename selected in Content panel)
Shift + Tab	Rename previous (with filename selected in Content panel)
Ctrl + Alt + 1	...to 5: Show items with star rating of 1-5 or higher in Filter panel
Ctrl + Alt + Shift + 1	...to 5: Show items with selected star rating in Filter panel
Ctrl + Alt + 6	...to 9: Show items with labels 1-4 in Filter panel
Shift + Left click	Show all items with selected rating or higher in Filter panel
Ctrl + Alt + A	Clear filters
Alt + Left click	Select inverse in Filter panel
Left click	Display Loupe tool in Preview panel or Review mode
Left click or Left click + Move the mouse	Move Loupe tool
Left click	Display additional Loupes in Preview panel (multiple selection)
Ctrl + Left click or Ctrl + Left click + Move the mouse	Move multiple Loupe tools simultaneously
+	Zoom in with Loupe tool
-	Zoom out with Loupe tool
Ctrl + +	Zoom in with Loupe tool (multiple selections)
Ctrl + -	Zoom out with Loupe tool (multiple selections)
Alt + Left click	Select all items in a stack
Shift + Left click	Apply or remove current keyword and all parent keywords in Keywords panel
Alt + Left click	Forcibly remove current keyword in Keywords panel
Ctrl + Right arrow	Open disclosure triangle in Keywords panel
Ctrl + Left arrow	Close disclosure triangle in Keywords panel
