Text selection with keyboard:	
Cmd + A	Select all
Ctrl + Cmd + U then A	Select none
Shift + Left arrow / Right arrow	Extend selection one character
Shift + Up arrow / Down arrow	Extend selection one line
Shift + Fn + Left arrow	Extend selection to the beginning of the line
Option + Shift + Up arrow / Down arrow	Extend selection one paragraph
Shift + Fn + Right arrow	Extend selection to the end of the line
Cmd + Shift + Up arrow	Extend selection to the beginning of the document
Cmd + Shift + Down arrow	Extend selection to the end of the document
Ctrl + Cmd + Shift + E then I	Select current list item
Ctrl + Cmd + Shift + E then O	Select all list items at current level

After selecting one section of text, Ctrl + ⌘ + Shift + Left/right arrow. Use left/right arrow to move to a separate section of text you also want to select:
Select multiple sections of text

Text selection with mouse:

Double click	Select word
Double click + Move the mouse	Extend selection one word at a time
Click three times (rapidly)	Select paragraph
Click three times (rapidly) + Move the mouse	Extend selection one paragraph at a time

Screen reader shortcuts

The shortcuts below help you work with a screen reader. Before you use them, you'll need to turn on screen reader support.

Option + Cmd + Z	Enable screen reader support	Ctrl + Cmd + N then 1	... to 6: Move to next heading [1-6]
Cmd + Option + H	Enable braille support	Ctrl + Cmd + P then 1	... to 6: Move to previous heading [1-6]
Ctrl + Cmd + A then X	Verbalize selection	Ctrl + Cmd + N then G	Move to next media (image or drawing)
Ctrl + Cmd + A then R	Verbalize from cursor location	Ctrl + Cmd + P then G	Move to previous media (image or drawing)

Navigation shortcuts			
Two groups of shortcuts below help you move quickly through your document or table:			
Move to the next or previous item with Ctrl + □ + n or Ctrl + □ + p followed by another key.			
Move quickly around a table with Ctrl + □ + Shift + t followed by another key.
