After selecting one section of text, Ctrl + Alt + Shift + Left/right arrow. Use left/right arrow to move to a separate section of text you also want to select: Select multiple sections of text		
Text selection with mouse:		
Double click	Select word	
Double click + Move the mouse	Extend selection one word at a time	

Click three times (rapidly)	Select paragraph
Click three times (rapidly) + Move the mouse	Extend selection one paragraph at a time
<h2>Screen reader shortcuts</h2>	
The shortcuts below help you work with a screen reader. Before you use them, turn on screen reader support. Learn how to turn on screen reader support.	
Screen reader support:	
Ctrl + Alt + Z or Alt + Shift + ~	Enable screen reader support
Ctrl + Alt + H	Enable braille support
Ctrl + Alt + A then X	Verbalize selection
Ctrl + Alt + A then R	Verbalize from cursor location
Ctrl + Alt + A then L	Announce cursor location
Ctrl + Alt + A then F	Announce formatting at cursor location
Ctrl + Alt + Shift + T then H	Verbalize table row and column headers
Ctrl + Alt + Shift + T then N	Verbalize table cell location
Ctrl + Alt + Shift + T then R	Verbalize table row header
Ctrl + Alt + Shift + T then C	Verbalize table column header
Ctrl + Alt + Shift + R	Show live edits
Ctrl + Alt + A then C	Verbalize comment
Ctrl + Alt + A then A	Verbalize comment anchor
Ctrl + Alt + A then S	Verbalize selection formatting
Ctrl + Alt + Shift + A then L	Verbalize cursor location

Two groups of shortcuts below help you move quickly through your document or table:

Move to the next or previous item with Ctrl + Alt + n or Ctrl + Alt + p followed by another key.

Move quickly around a table with Ctrl + Alt + Shift + t followed by another key.
