With iPadOS, Photos app provides a set of new keyboard shortcuts.

Safari

Safari is better in iPadOS thanks to new shortcuts. We have listed those shortcuts below:

Cmd + L	Open location
Cmd + [	Back
Cmd + T	New tab
Shift + Cmd + N	New private tab *
Cmd + Left click	(tap link) Open link in background *
Shift + Cmd + Left click	(tap link) Open link in new tab *
Cmd + W	Close tab
Shift + Cmd + T	Reopen last closed tab
Control + Shift + Tab	Show previous tab
Control + Tab	Show next tab
Cmd + R	Reload page
Cmd + F	Find on page
Cmd + +	Zoom in *
Cmd + -	Zoom out *
Cmd + 0	Actual size *
Shift + Cmd + D	Add to reading list
Cmd + D	Add bookmark...
Shift + Cmd + \	Show tab overview
Shift + Cmd + R	Show reader
Shift + Cmd + L	Show sidebar
Shift + Left click	(tap link) Add link to reading list *
Option + Left click	(tap link) Download link *

Cmd + S	Save as... *
Control + Cmd + 1	Show bookmarks *
Control + Cmd + 2	Show reading list *
Control + Cmd + 3	Show history *
Shift + Cmd + B	Hide favorites bar
Option + Cmd + B	Edit bookmarks
Option + Cmd + W	Close other tabs *
Cmd + 1	Show first tab *
Cmd + 9	Show last tab *
Cmd + E	Use selection for find *
Cmd + I	Email current page *
Option + Cmd + R	Reload page from origin
Cmd + Shift + Option + V	Paste without formatting *
Cmd + Enter	Open search result
Cmd + Option + F	Focus Smart Search field *
Option + Tab	Change focused element *

* New in iPadOS/iOS13

Some shortcuts, including Cmd + N to "Open split view" is removed in iPadOS. Cmd + N now opens a new tab like Cmd + T.

General iPad shortcuts

Cmd + H	Go to Home screen
Cmd + Space	Show or hide Search field
Cmd + Tab	Switch to the next most recently used app between open apps
Cmd + Shift + 3	Take a screenshot
Cmd + Shift + 4	Take a screenshot and open Markup to view or edit it

Cmd + Option + D Show or hide the Dock

Keyboard shortcuts can be customized by going to Settings > Accessibility > Keyboards, tapping Full Keyboard Access to turn it on, then by tapping Commands and pressing a custom key combination.
