Alt + Tab	Walk through windows

Working with windows: Panning and zooming

KDE Plasma Workspaces allows you to zoom in and out and move your entire desktop around, therefore you can zoom in even when the application you are using doesn't support it.

Meta + =	Zoom In
Meta + -	Zoom Out
Meta + Up arrow	Pan Up
Meta + Left arrow	Pan left

Meta + Q	Manage Activities
Meta + Tab	Next Activity
Ctrl + F1	Switch to Desktop 1

Ctrl + F12 Show Desktop
