General mouse controls

Ships:

Left click	(on own ship) Select own ship

Hold Ctrl to select several own ships

Left click + Move the mouse	(pull square around ships) Select several ships

Right click	(on enemy ship) Attack ship

Town:

Left click	(on action buildings) Enter building

Left click	(on facility or town house) Display information

Left click	(on citizens) Find out their opinion

Left click	(on dock crane) Open trade between trading office and town

Left click	(on town button in sea map) 1. Enter town (if own ship or trading office is in town)

Left click	(on town button in sea map) 2. Display town info (if you haven't either of above)
