



Celluloid 0.23 cheat sheet

General

Ctrl + O	Open file
Ctrl + L	Open location
Ctrl + Shift + O	Add file to playlist
Ctrl + Shift + L	Add location to playlist
Ctrl + P	Show preferences dialog
Ctrl + H	Toggle controls
F9	Toggle playlist
F11 or F	Fullscreen
Esc	Leave fullscreen mode
Shift + O	Toggle OSD states between normal and playback time/duration
Shift + I	Show filename on the OSD
O or Shift + P	Show progress, elapsed time, and duration on the OSD

Seeking

Left arrow / Right arrow	Seek backward/forward 5 seconds
Shift + Left arrow / Right arrow	Exact seek backward/forward 1 second
Up arrow / Down arrow	Seek forward/backward 1 minute
Shift + Up arrow / Down arrow	Exact seek forward/backward 5 seconds
Ctrl + Left arrow / Right arrow	Seek to previous/next subtitle
, or .	Step backward/forward a single frame
Page Up / Down	Seek to the beginning of the previous/next chapter

Playback

[	Decrease playback speed by 10%
]	Increase playback speed by 10%
{	Halve current playback speed
}	Double current playback speed
Backspace	Reset playback speed to normal

< Go backward/forward in the playlist

Del	Remove selected playlist item
Ctrl + Shift + S	Save playlist
L	Set/clear A-B loop points
Shift + L	Toggle infinite looping
P	Pause or unpause
Space or Ctrl + Q	Quit
Q or Shift + Q	Save current playback position and quit

Playlist

Ctrl + F	Enter search mode
Ctrl + G	Jump to next match
Ctrl + Shift + G	Jump to previous match
Esc	Exit search mode

Audio

#	Cycle through audio tracks
/	Decrease volume
*	Increase volume
9	Decrease volume
0	Increase volume
M	Mute/unmute
Ctrl + + or Ctrl + -	Adjust audio delay by +/- 0.1 seconds

Subtitles

V	Toggle subtitle visibility
J or Shift + J	Cycle through available subtitles
Z or Shift + Z	Adjust subtitle delay by +/- 0.1 seconds
U	Toggle SSA/ASS subtitles style override
R or Shift + R	Move subtitles up/down
Shift + V	Toggle VSFilter aspect compatibility mode

Videos

_	Cycle through video tracks
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W or Shift + W	Decrease/increase pan-and-scan range
S	Take a screenshot
Shift + S	Take a screenshot, without subtitles
Ctrl + S	Take a screenshot, as the window shows it
Alt + 0	Resize video to half its original size"
Alt + 1	Resize video to its original size
Alt + 2	Resize video to double its original size
1 or 2	Adjust contrast
3 or 4	Adjust brightness
5 or 6	Adjust gamma
7 or 8	Adjust saturation
D	Activate or deactivate deinterlacer
Shift + A	Cycle aspect ratio override
