Cmd + Option + C	Add or change a packet comment
Cmd + Option + Shift + C	Capture file properties

Cmd + Shift + I	Create a packet list column from the selected field
Cmd + Shift + E	Enable and disable specific protocols
Cmd + G	Go to specified packet
Cmd + D	Ignore or unignore each selected packet
Cmd + Shift + F	Reload as File Format/Capture
Cmd + Shift + L	Reload Lua plugins
Cmd + Option + Shift + H	Follow HTTP Stream
Cmd + Option + Shift + T	Follow TCP Stream
Cmd + Option + Shift + S	Follow TLS Stream
Cmd + Option + Shift + U	Follow UDP Stream

## Capture

Cmd + K	Capture options
F5	Refresh interfaces
Cmd + R	Restart current capture
Cmd + E	Start capturing packets
Cmd + E	Stop capturing packets

## Time

Cmd + Option + 1 yoki Cmd + Option + 2	Show packet times as the date and time of day
Cmd + Option + 3	Show packet times as the seconds since the UNIX / POSIX epoch (1970-01-01).
Cmd + Option + 4	Show packet times as the date and time of day.
Cmd + Option + 5	Show packet times as the seconds since the previous captured packet.
Cmd + Option + 6	Show packet times as the seconds since the previous displayed packet.
Cmd + Option + 7	Show packet times as the UTC date and time of day.
Cmd + Option + 8	Show packet times as the UTC time of day.
Cmd + Shift + T	Shift or change packet timestamps
Cmd + T	Set or unset a time reference for this packet
Cmd + Option + T	Remove all time references

## Navigation

Cmd + Home	Go to the first packet
Cmd + End	Go to the last packet

Cmd + Shift + N	Go to the next marked packet
Cmd + Shift + B	Go to the previous marked packet
Cmd + Down arrow	Go to the next packet
Cmd + Up arrow	Go to the previous packet
Option + Right arrow	Go to the next packet in your selection history
Option + Left arrow	Go to the previous packet in your selection history
Cmd + .	Go to the next packet in this conversation
Cmd + ,	Go to the previous packet in this conversation
Cmd + Option + N	Go to the next time reference
Cmd + Option + B	Go to the previous time reference
Cmd + N	Find the next packet
Cmd + F	Find a packet
Cmd + B	Find the previous packet

## Copy

Cmd + Option + Shift + D	Copy item's description
Cmd + Shift + C	Copy this item as a display filter
Cmd + Option + Shift + F	Copy this item's field name
Cmd + Option + Shift + V	Copy this item's value
Cmd + Option + Shift + A	Copy all Visible Items
Cmd + Shift + O	Show Packet Bytes...
Cmd + Shift + X	Export Packet Bytes...

## Display

Cmd + Left arrow	Collapse all packet details
Shift + Left arrow	Collapse the current packet detail
Cmd + Right arrow	Expand packet details
Shift + Right arrow	Expand the current packet detail
Cmd + -	Shrink the main window text

Cmd + +	Enlarge the main window text
Control + Cmd + F	Full Screen
Cmd + Shift + D	Ignore all displayed packets
Cmd + D	Ignore or unignore each selected packet
Cmd + Shift + M	Mark all displayed packets
Cmd + M	Mark or unmark each selected packet
Cmd + Shift + W	Reset appearance layout to default size
Cmd + Space	Reset colorized conversations
Cmd + Shift + R	Resize packet list columns to fit contents
Cmd + 0	Return the main window text to its normal size
Cmd + Option + D	Unignore all displayed packets
Cmd + Option + M	Unmark all displayed packets
