Vim cheat sheet

General

Esc	Gets out of the current mode into the "command mode". All keys are bound of commands
I	"Insert mode" for inserting text. Keys behave as expected
:	"Last-line mode". In this mode, Vim expects you to enter a command such as to save the document

Navigation keys

Н	Move the cursor one character to the left
K	Move the cursor up one line
0	Move the cursor to the beginning of the line
G then G	Move to the beginning of the file

Navigate around the document

(Jump to the previous sentence
)	Jump to the next sentence

Insert text

Delete text

D then D

Simple replace text

R	Replace characters instead of
	inserting them

Copy/Paste text

Y then Y	Copy current line into storage buffer
Р	Paste storage buffer after current line
Р	Paste storage buffer before current line

Modify selected text

~ Switch case

Save and quit

: then Q	Quits Vim but fails when file has been changed
: then W	Save the file
: then W then Q	Save the file and quit Vim
Z then Z	Write file, if modified, and quit Vim
