Basic editing

Ctrl + C	Copy line (empty selection)
Ctrl +]	Indent/outdent line
Home	Go to beginning of line
End	Go to end of line
Alt + Page Up	Scroll page up
Alt + Page Down	Scroll page down
Ctrl + K then Ctrl +]	Unfold (uncollapse) all subregions
Ctrl + /	Toggle line comment

Navigation

Ctrl + T	Show all symbols
----------	------------------

Multi-cursor and selection

Alt + Left click	Insert cursor

Note: The Alt+Click shortcut may not work on some Linux distributions. You can change the modifier key for the Insert cursor command to Ctrl+Click with the “editor.multiCursorModifier” setting.
