Ctrl + Shift + D	Duplicate tab	
Ctrl + ,	Open settings	
Ctrl + Alt + ,	Open default settings file	
Ctrl + Shift + ,	Open settings file	
Ctrl + Shift + Up arrow	Scroll up	
Ctrl + Shift + Down arrow	Scroll down
