F	Feed (near wolf pup)
Esc	Pause gameplay / Options interface
Q	Toggle gait (sprint - trot)
V	Toggle Scent view
Num 9	Toggle headcam view
M	Toggle world map
?	Toggle Interface Help
R	Rest
R then R	Lay down
R then R then R	Stand up
Z	Sleep to advance the time of day
H	Howl
P	Urinate (Slough Creek only)
J	Wag Tail emote

N	Toggle nametags
,	Toggle Mouse cursor lock
O	Toggle camera orbit

RB (right bumper)	Target lock-on
RT (right trigger)	Sprint (Tap: Auto)
Left thumb stick	Movement
Left thumb stick - press	Jump
D-pad up	Emotes
D-pad down	Photo mode
D-pad left	Headcam
D-pad right	Favorite emote
Favorite emote can be set in Emotes panel (hold d-pad right)	
Right thumb stick	Orbit cam
RB (right bumper) + Right thumb stick	Camera zoom
Right thumb stick - press	Free cam
A button	Bite, eat, pick up, put down
B button	Mark territory
X button	Main howl
X button then X button	Secondary howl
Y button	Rest
Y button	(hold) Sleep
View button	Map, Quests, Pack info
Menu button	Options menu
